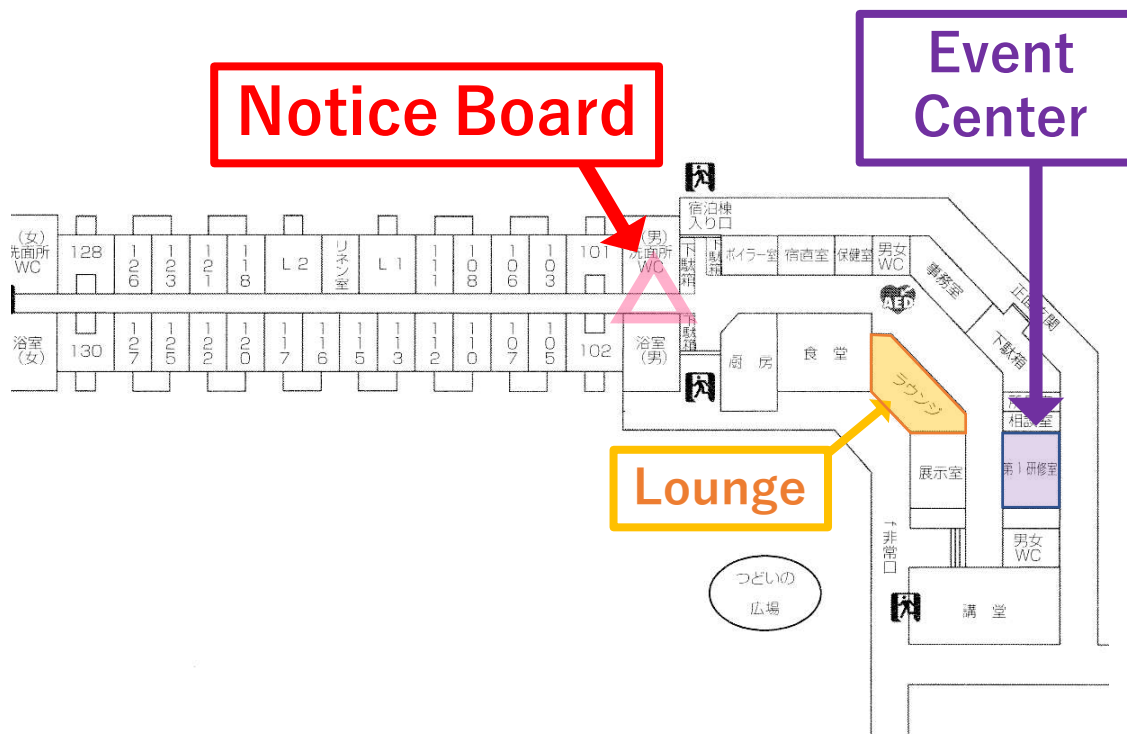
- Information about the accommodation and the meals will be announced on the notice board.

p.26 Quarantine

OLD It is located indoors at the accommodation and opens at 10:30 and all competitors have to check in before 12:00.

NEW It is located indoors at the accommodation and opens at 10:30 and all competitors **and all officials** have to check in before 12:00.

OLD Competitors and team officials who do not enter the quarantine will be handed a map with a marked route to the arena and must arrive at the arena by 12:30.

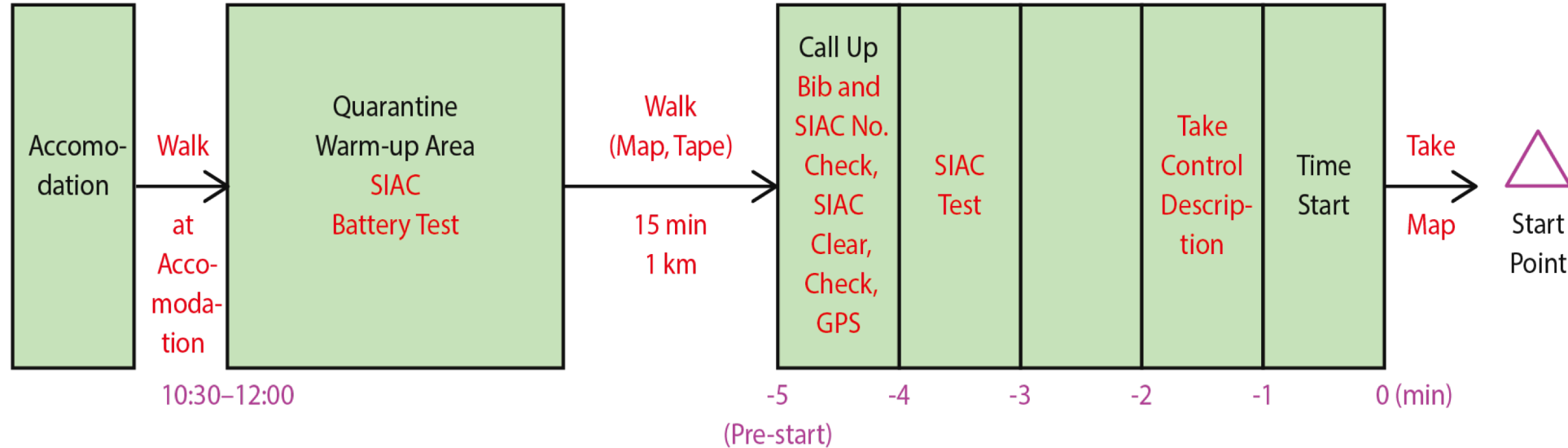

Quarantine in Sprint

- Check in from 10:30 to 12:00.
- Bags can be transported to the arena after the start close.
- **Bring ~~the room key~~ to the quarantine by 12:00. → Organizers will lock all the room. Key is secured by organizers. Go Arena OK but return prohibited!**



Battery Check

- Check if your SIAC card shows "OK" in the quarantine.
- If "WARNING" or "FAIL" is shown, tell an organizer immediately in the **quarantine** and get another card at the **pre-start**.

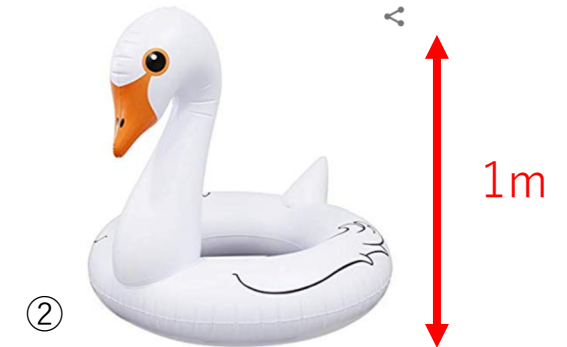

Impassable fences

- There are several temporary impassable fences in the sprint terrain.
 - ① Yellow and Black rope
 - ② Orange net
- Competitors are strictly forbidden to **pass over or punch SIAC over the impassable fences.**
- When organizers find it, the competitors will be **disqualified.**

Ditches along paved footpath

- There are ditches along footpath, which are **not shown on the maps**;
 - ① with Yellow and Black rope;
 - ② without any ropes.
- **Be aware of it.**

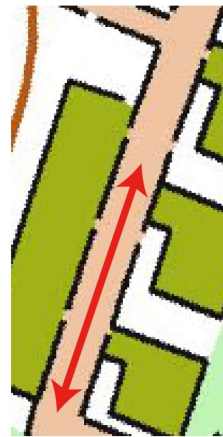

GPS tracking

GPS tracking

- In M20/W20 (Sprint and Middle Distance) and MW20 (Sprint Relay), there is GPS tracking for selected persons.

GPS vest

- All competitors in M20/W20 and MW20 need to wear GPS vests in every race. Vests will be handed out after TOM.
- Ask at the event center **today by 21:00** in order to change the size.
- Team officials have to return all GPS vests of the team to the **event center at the accommodation** after Middle Distance before the banquet.

Q: How to move Arena from Pre-start area. Map or Tape will be provided for officials?

A: Maps to the arena will be provided.

Q: Is water available at Team Zone in Arena?

A: No. Water bottles will be provided when competitors finish.

Q: Is there a roof in the Team Zone?

A: Yes.

Q&A

Q: The material will be distributed ?

A: Uploaded to the official web after the TOM.

Bibs will be provided at the quarantine

Q: Explain more about tent, please

A: Not prepared 1 tent for each country.

Q: Interval 2 min? even though 1 min in IOF rule.

A: Because of high visibility. → approved.

Q: Which time to be shown?

A: Current time, because radio wave correction system is in use. Organiser will call up the runners' bib no.

→ approved.

Q: Can team officials go to pre-start?

A: Yes, but once you go to pre-start, you can't come back the quarantine.

Q: Do we have to insert SI card at the Finish?

A: No need to punch. You need to hand over at the finish station.

Q: At the pre-start, can you transport runners' baggage or clothes?

A: In quarantine, there is bag drop, and Organizers will transport to Arena. No transport in pre-start.

Q: Yellow and black rope fence looks passable. Is it impassable?

A : It is impassable fences because of danger.
