前橋

- 1. Minimum age of participation is age 13, born in or before 2006.
- 2. In each individual class, each country may enter a maximum of **5 competitors**.
- 3. Each country may enter **2 temas** in each relay class but only the better-placed team will be counted in the prize list.
- 4. If a federation is unable to form full relay teams (even with women running in mens classes), it may form incomplete teams or mixed teams with runners from other federations. Under no circumstances may persons other than entered competitors participate in the competition. Teams with runners from more than one federation are not placed on the official result list.
- 5. Competitors representing member federations of the IOF, defined by the International Olympic Committee as belonging to the Asian continent, can compete in AsJYOC.
- 6. Competitors representing other member federations of IOF or other Asian countries can participate in AsJYOC but will not be eligible for the AsJYOC titles, medals or diplomas.
- 7. The winners of the age class 20, 18 and 16 will be Youth Champions of the AsJYOC respectively. The winners of the age class 14 will not be eligible for the AsJYOC titles.
