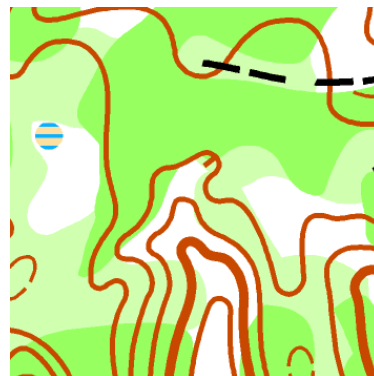

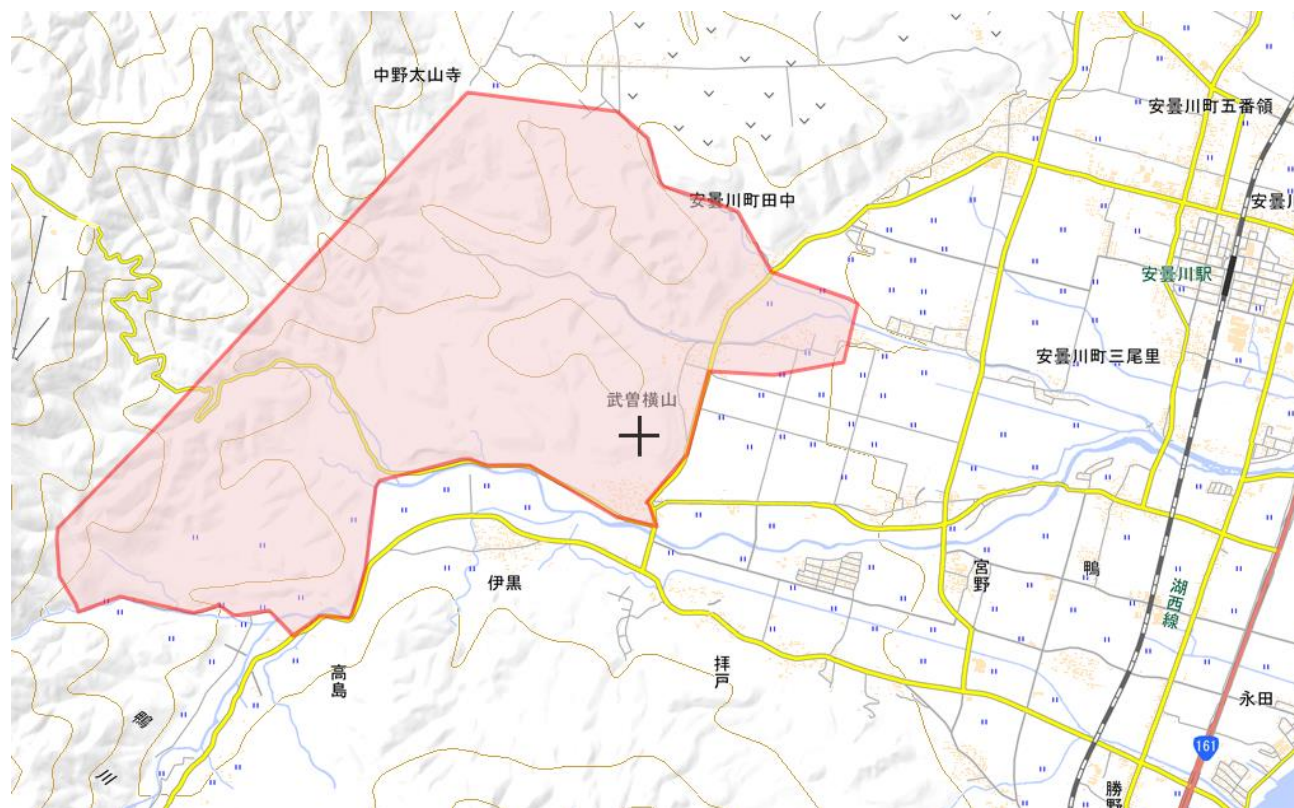

On the other hand, Valley area make detailed landform and steep cliff <vegetation> There is area of very good runnability (mainly tree plantation). But, there is area of low runnability and visibility with shrub or fallen trees probably caused by last year's typhoon.

Level

There are 4 levels.

Beginner: Controls and routes are all on road, footpath, and definite line objects.

Intermediate: Many of routes are on road and footpath. But a certain area is out of path or on indistinct line objects. You may need to read landform.

Advance: You should read landforms and use compass.

Elite: You should read detailed landforms and attack finely.

Prizes

Champion

- M21E, W21E, M20E, W20E 1st place in Japanese runners on each day will be prized as 2019's champion.

Prize

- upper 6 places on M21E, W21E, M20E, W20E on each day.
- upper 3 places on the other classes on each day.

Clothing and Gear

- There are no regulations regarding clothing and shoes. But We recommend to wear long shirts, long pants, eye protector, **and metal spike shoes**.
- GPS-enabled devices (watches etc.) can be carried provided that they have no map display and are not used for navigation purposes.
